- Assessors will check you have up-to-date certificates for fire alarms, electrics, fire extinguishers etc
- For larger venues we will check you have key written policies and procedures such as a drug policy, under-age sales policy or noise control policy, and check that staff understand them
- For smaller venues we will talk to staff to check they understand and apply your policies and procedures
